

## Cabur Policy on “Conflict Minerals”

On January 1<sup>st</sup> 2021, the Regulation issued by the European Union EU 2017/821 concerning minerals from conflict-affected areas came into force.

Previously, in August 2012, the United States Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) had also issued the definitive rules relating to the so-called "Conflict Minerals" (known as '3TG' - Tantalum, Tin, Tungsten, Gold - mined in areas of violent conflict) in section 1502 of the "Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act".

Cabur is a “downstream user” and “articles producer / supplier” company and, because of the nature and the characteristics of its own business, has no obligations under the EU Regulation 2017/821. At the same time, Cabur is not listed on any US stock exchange, and is therefore not legally obligated to meet SEC requirements or to issue reports on Conflict Minerals.

However, Cabur is opposed to violence and any violation of human rights and therefore supports the aims and objectives of international legislation on the procurement of so-called Conflict Minerals. For this reason, on the basis of its corporate responsibility, Cabur asks its suppliers high social, environmental and respect for human rights standards.

Cabur carries out “due diligence” operations in relation to Conflict Minerals and, to the present knowledge, can affirm that no metal contained in its products is derived from minerals coming from conflict zones.

Cabur also undertakes to:

- do not knowingly purchase products and materials containing metals coming from minerals extracted in mines located in conflict-affected areas;
- work with its suppliers to ensure that any metal present in its products and any materials supplied to Cabur come from sources located in conflict-free areas.

In working towards these commitments Cabur asks its suppliers to undertake reasonable due diligence activities on their supply chains to ensure that specified metals are sourced only from reliable and responsible mines and smelters.
